



**Bonol International, Inc. Net Income Increases 155 Percent for the  
December Quarter on a Revenue Increase of 41 Percent**

**Shareholder Equity Increases 34 Percent**

ROYAL OAK, Mich., Feb 01, 2008 — Bonol International, Inc. (OTC: BONL) today announced nine month and third quarter ending December 31, 2007 unaudited results.

Year to date, shareholder equity is up 34% from last year and nine month revenue increased 26%. Net income increased by 41% at the nine month period.

Quarterly revenue for Bonol International increased 41% from \$421,339 at Dec. 31, 2006 to \$594,917 at Dec. 31, 2007. Bonol's third quarter net income is \$97,468 up 155% from \$38,126 last year. Bonol's per share net income for the quarter is \$0.06 compared to \$0.02 last year. Earnings per share year to date went from \$0.16 last year to \$0.23 per share at Dec. 31, 2007.
